

# Texas Communists Prepare Big Drive

HOUSTON, May 23.—Officers of the Texas State Communist party mapped plans Monday for a drive to elect candidates acceptable to their ideologies in the state general elections next November.

College boys and negro longshoremen were included in the 50 or so delegates who convened Sunday in an unpainted three-room shack and chose their officers in comparative secrecy. Visitors were asked to leave before the meeting got under way.

Emma Tenayuca Brooks, San Antonio labor leader, was elected state chairman of the party. Homer Brooks of Houston was named secretary and Jeff Cleburne of Corpus Christi administrative secretary. Delegates were chosen to attend the party's national convention in New York, May 26.
